Project Overview Report September Board Meeting September 30, 2009

MSBA staff continues to utilize the attached charts to gauge and track progress of projects that have been moved into the MSBA's capital pipeline. Since the Board's meeting in November, 2007, the number of projects in the capital pipeline has grown from 83 to a total of 123. Once the MSBA Board of Directors has approved a District for a Feasibility Study or Repair Assessment, the District must obtain local funding and procure the team of professionals that will work with them through the study, and if a project is approved, through design, construction and close-out of the project. Obtaining funding, assembling a team of professionals and completing the following steps are critical in making progress on a project:

- Owner's Project Manager (OPM) advertising, interviewing, selection and MSBA approval
- Designer Selection advertising, interviewing and selection by Designer Selection Panel
- Enrollment Agreement reviewing enrollments and reaching agreement on capacity of the school/district

To assist Districts through this process, the MSBA has developed many standard forms and tools which help expedite the process:

- Template Requests for Services (RFS) For OPMs and Designers, the MSBA has a standard template RFS which the district should use when advertising for OPM or Designer Services.
- Standard Submission Packets The OPM Review Panel and the Designer Selection Panel have standard packages of information that need to be submitted by potential candidates. This provides consistency and facilitates the procurement process. The OPM Review Panel and the Designer Selection Panel meetings are open to the public and the schedules are posted on our website.
- Standard Contracts Once the OPMs and Designers have been selected, the MSBA has standard contracts for both OPM services and Designer services. These contracts were designed with input from the OPM and Designer communities and contain many provisions that are aimed at protecting the District. Also, having standard contracts saves time in negotiations.
- Enrollment Projection Tool The MSBA developed a web-based enrollment projection tool that allows districts to generate enrollment projections at no cost. The enrollment projection tool is easy to use and requires a relatively small amount of data collection by the districts from readily available data sources. No longer are districts required to hire a demographer to look at enrollment trends. The MSBA and the District have a dialogue and share information, which leads to an agreed upon enrollment, a letter from the MSBA and a signed enrollment certification.

Highlights since the July 29, 2009 Board Meeting:

Local Vote Authorization

The number of Districts now requiring a local funding appropriation to conduct Feasibility Study/Schematic Design Phase increased by thirteen, a direct result of new projects voted into the capital pipeline at the July Board Meeting, for a new total of twenty seven Districts in need of local funding authorization. The Town of Granby was able to secure funding for the Feasibility Study/Schematic Design at its fall Town Meeting. Since the last Board Meeting, a significant number of Districts have established dates to authorize funds in support of the Board Approved Project Scope and Budget Agreement.

Owner's Project Managers

An additional four Districts have submitted their OPM selections to the MSBA and two received approval, two are under review. The additional OPM selections are offset by the increased number of Districts in the Capital Pipeline which brings the total percentage of OPMs selected from 77.5% to 68% of the Districts in the Capital Pipeline that require an OPM.

Designers

An additional designer has been selected by the Designer Selection Panel. In addition, five districts are currently procuring designers utilizing local design selection processes for those projects under \$5 million. Due to the additional projects that were added to the capital pipeline at the last Board meeting the total percentage of designers selected has decreased from 61% to 57%. (Otherwise, the rate would have risen to 64% without the additional projects.) Forty two Districts in the Capital Pipeline are in process with procurement or still need to begin a designer selection process.

Design Enrollment

The MSBA has received seven additional signed enrollment certifications increasing the total number of districts for which the MSBA has reached agreed on a design enrollment to 37.

Commissioning

Since the last Board meeting, we have been working to develop a process by which Commissioning Consultants from the approved list are assigned to projects. This development has included:


- The drafting of a Master Commissioning Services Agreement to establish the terms and conditions that govern the arrangement between the MSBA and each of the commissioning consultants
- The drafting of a Standard Scope of Commissioning Services to be attached to each Work Order that establish the procedural and technical requirements for each project
- Development of written procedures for the selection and assignment of Commissioning Consultants for specific project. In general, the procedures establish a Request for Proposal process through which the MSBA will solicit proposals from three of the eleven approved Commissioning Consultants. Respondents will submit a fee proposal along with a description of their proposed approach to the project and include any variations or exceptions proposed to the Standard Scope of Commissioning Services.

We have commenced with commissioning selection for four projects in the capital pipeline: renovations to the Village Elementary School in Marblehead, the new Putnam Vocational Technical High School in Springfield, the new Hanover High School and the new North High School in Plymouth. This initial selection has engaged each of the eleven approved Commissioning Consultants and we are in the final stages of awarding a work order for each of the four projects.

Local Vote Authorization

Of the one hundred twenty three projects within MSBA's capital pipeline, twenty seven Districts need to secure authorization or funding. Fifty-four projects received authorization and funding for feasibility study only. The remaining fifty four projects have received authorization and funding for project funding agreements.





■ No Funding Appropriated

Owner's Project Manager (OPM) Review Panel

Since the last Board meeting, four additional Districts have completed the OPM selection process raising the total number of OPM approvals to 58. The MSBA has now approved 68% of the Districts currently in the capital pipeline that require an OPM.

Designer Selection Panel

Since the last report to the Board, the Designer Selection Panel has met two times. (There were no meetings in August.) In order to address the ongoing demand, staff are working with Districts to schedule their participation in Designer Selection Panels with Panel dates tentatively scheduled twice monthly through December 15, 2009.



As indicated in the table above, one district participated and one district completed the Designer Selection process since the last report to the Board. Additionally, Ashland, Dartmouth, North Attleboro, and Rockport are in the process of locally procuring designers for repair projects. A total of 71 districts have completed the process since the inception of the Designer Selection Panel.

The Designer Selection Panel provides opportunities for firms interested in providing designer services for Massachusetts K-12 public school projects funded through the MBSA to present their qualifications to the Designer Selection Panel in a non-project-specific informational interview. These interviews are not mandatory but are offered as an opportunity for designers to introduce themselves to the DSP and present information about their overall qualifications, experience and approach. To date, 57 firms have requested informational interviews and 23 firms have presented.

As noted previously, the Designer Selection Panel will continue to meet twice per month as needed to address the district demand for procurement of designers.



Design Enrollment


