Discussion

The OPM and Designer conducted a feasibility analysis of the facility and developed a schematic design including a proposed scope of work, schedule, and estimated budget. The District's Designer, CSS Architects Inc., recommends an exterior window and door replacement at the Lt. Peter M. Hansen Elementary School and an exterior window and

door replacement at the William H. Galvin Middle School. The Designer has confirmed that the projects will be in compliance with the MSBA's sustainability requirements.

MSBA staff reviewed the consultants' existing conditions analysis and proposed schedule provided by the District and have discussed the scope and budget with the District and its consultants. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$2,232,150 which includes a construction cost of \$1,748,799.

Construction costs include:

- Hansen Elementary School
 - \$103/sf for exterior windows and doors, and
 - \$381,563 for demolition and associated work
- Galvin Middle School
 - \$123/sf for exterior windows and doors, and
 - \$443,860 for associated work

MSBA staff recommends an estimated maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$1,006,923; however, the District may be eligible for up to an additional \$43,805 in grant funds, subject to the MSBA's review and audit of the District's owner's and construction contingency expenditures. Accordingly, staff recommends a maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$1,050,728 for the Project Funding Agreement for the exterior window and door replacements at the Lt. Peter M. Hansen Elementary School and the William H. Galvin Middle School.
