Discussion

MSBA staff reviewed the documents provided by the District and met with the District and its consultants to discuss scope and budget. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$37,999,940, which includes an estimated construction cost of \$30,776,990 (\$174/sf). The basis of the Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant would be \$35,625,727, which excludes costs associated with abatement of asbestos-containing flooring materials, work beyond school property, removal of existing fuel storage tanks, work associated with renovation of the existing auditorium, and owner's and construction contingency costs.

MSBA staff recommends an Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$28,500,581; however, the District may be eligible for up to an additional \$1,600,000 in grant funds, subject to the MSBA's review and audit of the District's owner's and construction contingency expenditures. Accordingly, staff recommends a Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$30,100,581 for the Project Scope and Budget Agreement and Project Funding Agreement for a renovation project at the existing Chicopee Academy (former Chicopee High School facility) to serve as a middle school for grades 6-8.

² Does not include any grant funds for potentially eligible owner's or construction contingency expenditures; subject to MSBA review and audit.

³ Includes maximum possible owner's and construction contingency grant funds, the final amount of which, if any, shall be determined by the MSBA in its sole discretion.
