The MSBA has provisionally included two (2) incentive points for energy efficiency, subject to the District meeting certain sustainability requirements for the project. If the District does not meet the requirements for the energy efficiency, the District will not qualify for these incentive points, and the MSBA will adjust the reimbursement rate and grant amount accordingly.

Discussion

MSBA staff reviewed the documents provided by the District and met with the District and its consultants to discuss scope and budget. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$54,301,695 which includes an estimated construction cost of \$43,122,257 (\$342/sf). The basis of the Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant would be \$43,924,501, which excludes ineligible costs associated with abatement of asbestos-containing floor materials, site costs in excess of 8% of total building cost, costs associated with mailing and moving, costs of any ineligible site work or any work associated with the district offices, costs beyond the allowance per student for furnishings, fixtures, and equipment, and owner's and construction contingency costs.

MSBA staff recommends an Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$25,445,463; however, the District may be eligible for up to an additional \$1,930,481 in grant funds, subject to the MSBA's review and audit of the District's owner's and construction contingency expenditures. Accordingly, staff recommends a Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$27,375,945 for the Project Scope and Budget Agreement and Project Funding Agreement to replace the existing Mountview Middle School with the construction of a new middle school serving grades 6-8 on the existing site.

² Does not include any grant funds for potentially eligible owner's or construction contingency expenditures; subject to MSBA review and audit.

³ Includes maximum possible owner's and construction contingency grant funds, the final amount of which, if any, shall be determined by the MSBA in its sole discretion. The MSBA does not anticipate that the District will expend all of its contingency funds on expenses that are eligible for MSBA reimbursement.
